A+ Requirements

A+ Requirements

To be certified as an A+ student, the individual must do the following in grades 9-12:

1. Sign an A+ Agreement;
2. Attend an A+ designated high school for three years immediately prior to graduation;
3. Maintain a 2.5 or higher grade point average (GPA);
4. Maintain at least a 95% attendance record for grades 9-12;
5. Perform 50 hours of unpaid school-sponsored tutoring/mentoring for other students;
6. Maintain a record of good citizenship and avoid the unlawful use of drugs and/or alcohol;
7. Apply for federal post-secondary student financial assistance funds that do not require repayment by submitting a FAFSA form between January 1 and April 1 of the student's senior year; www.fafsa.ed.gov
8. Register with the Selective Service at age 18 for males or as required by law;

Not required for certification, but must be declared in order for the funds to be available for tuition:

9. When enrolling in college or technical school, the student must declare a major or course of study.

Additional requirement for Class of 2015

In addition to the listing above the student must score proficient or advanced on the official Algebra EOC

- If a student does not meet the requirement for Algebra I EOC then the student must complete the first semester at a post-secondary institution with a minimum of twelve (12) hours or the equivalent and a 2.5 or higher GPA to receive A+ tuition reimbursement.
